



ALL Team Scores Win in Basketball Game and for Charities

WASHINGTON (Sept. 25, 2008) - The American League of Lobbyists (ALL) came away with a dominant 47-32 win over congressional members in a fight on the basketball court for charity at the George Washington University Sept. 15.

Putting partisan politics aside, lobbyists and congressional members and staffers took to the court at the Hoops for Youth Foundation's 10th annual Hoops for Hope All-Star Classic. The American League of Lobbyists was a sponsor of the event, and fielded two teams of its members for games against congressional staff and members of Congress.

The members of Congress hoped to avenge last year's loss to the ALL by recruiting two freshman members of the House, Brad Ellsworth, D-Ind., and Steve Scalise, R-La., but they were no match for the ALL team. Georgetown University basketball coach, John Thompson III, who coached the members, tried to rally his players in the second half by yelling into the microphone to distract the ALL team, but his efforts were in vain.

Rep. Jay Inslee, D-Wash., was the leading scorer for the members, while Paul Miller of Miller/Wenhold Strategies led the way for the ALL under the coaching of the George Washington University's Karl Hobbs.

The staffers, on the other hand, eked out a 42-40 win over the ALL II team. The staffers set the tone with a three-pointer by Melissa Shannon, an aide to House Speaker Nancy Pelosi, but were behind for most of the game. Facing a nine-point deficit at the end of the third quarter, the staffers mounted a comeback and won the game on a couple of crucial free throws by Andy Keiser and Jeff Mortier.

While the games provided bragging rights to those who won, they also raised money for several Washington, D.C.-area children's charities through the Hoops for Youth Foundation. A silent auction was also held to help raise funds. More than \$400,000 has been raised since the event's inception.
